In our label artwork you'll find the fated freighter's name handwritten by the ship's first mate, father of co-owner Pat and Dan Conway's childhood friend. The number 29 represents the crew who lost their lives. It's with great respect that we brew Edmund Fitzgerald Porter in their memory.

ABOUT THE STYLE:

Porters originated in Great Britain and were named after the porters who hauled goods from wagons to open air markets. The Robust Porter style is slightly more aggressive than its English ancestor, known for bitter roasted malt flavors with subtle sweetness and a clean hop presence. Robust Porters are dark in color with a medium body and alcohol content.
